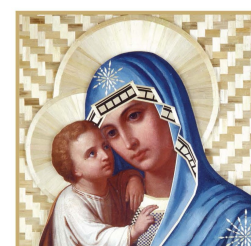

## Happy Mother's Day

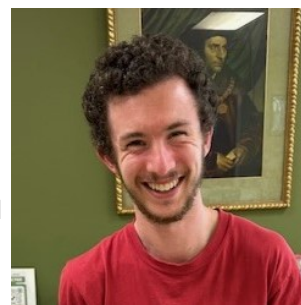
