Vincentian Retreat beckons big hearts
A Vincentian retreat is not a stoic departure, nor is it about Van Gogh. Instead it's an informal gathering of volunteers who dedicate themselves to the mission of St. Vincent de Paul: "We assist the poor and those in need of consolation."

Vincentians do it by working in teams to build resources and make home visits to people who ask St. Vincent de Paul for help. Through a partnership of more than 60 years, local Vincentians issue gift cards to St. Vinnie's stores so that individuals and families can obtain items as basic as clothing, beds and bedding, and housewares. Some Vincentian groups also help with rent or utilities; one also gives food boxes, and one also refurbishes and gives bikes. Most importantly, Vincentians themselves are changed as they look for the face of Christ in each person they encounter.
