The Bernie Conklin Scholarship is for current students at Lane Community College, a student transferring into LCC, or any high school student enrolling in LCC.

Scholarship Amounts:

- The Conklin Scholarship will be awarded to one individual in the amount of \$1,000.

Scholarship Prerequisites:

1. Applicant must be a current Undergrad enrolled at LCC, transferring from LCC to the U.O., or enrolling from high school into LCC.
2. Applicant must have a minimum GPA of 2.75.
3. Applicant needs to register with the UO Newman Center.
4. Applicant must establish a connection with the UO Newman community or ministry.

Application Packet Requirements:

1. Packets to be completed in full; **partial packets will not be considered for award.**
2. To include **Official Sealed Transcripts** from Lane Community College, from the transferring college, or high school.
 - **Copies and Web Printout will not be accepted.**
 - **Transcripts with the seal broken will not be accepted.**
3. To include two letters of recommendation that speak to your scholastic, personal characteristics, and accomplishments.
(No letters from relatives, peers, FOCUS, or the Newman Center staff.)
4. To include a photo of yourself.
