Stipend to Fr. Edgar was not in the budget but the students would like to have it monthly. Currently we are looking at quarterly.

- Aesthetic concerns with the Hardy Siding - Hardie Plank Siding is out due to warranty issues.

- Proposed windows. Who is the architect involved? - McIntyre Construction has done up the design and drawings. Professional architect would cost an additional \$20,000 for design only.
- Should the siding be a shingle-type siding? - This is still being evaluated. Fr. Peter has met with construction advisors, and we are checking into their recommendations with McIntyre Construction. Cost and longevity of the products being considered will also play factor in the final decision.
- Is the asbestos friable or not? - Uncertain, but this question seems irrelevant. The abatement company take responsibility in removing and disposal of all asbestos in accordance with all Oregon health and safety regulations.
